

Rules and Regulations

- **Every parent/student must sign a waiver in order participate.**
- Dancers are to wear proper attire
 - leotards
 - jazz or sweat pants
 - jazz, tap, flamenco (or character), or ballet shoes **must** be worn for each class
 - No spaghetti straps, no mid-drifts, no low cut shirts, no shorts
 - this is not only for decency but for the safety of the students
- Dancers are to wear hair up and out of their face. Hair shouldn't be a distraction during a dance class.
- Only 2 uncounted absences per semester or 3 absences with proper notification using the key on the roster.
- Please try to arrive 15 minutes early for class. Make sure if you have a younger child to take them to the restroom. All students should stretch and warm up before class. Make sure you pray, pray, pray before class
- **No food or drinks** on any carpeted areas except for water bottles. There is food and drinks allowed in The Cove but we ask, if you don't need it don't bring it.
- Parents are asked to wait outside during the dance class. At times, the instructor will invite parents to participate at the end of class.
- Parents must be present to drop off and pick up their child. Students under 7 will not be admitted into class or released without their parent present.
- Please be prompt picking up your child 5 minutes before the end of class.
- The entrance fee is a requirement for all student unless a scholarship form is filled out and turned in by 10/01/11. All scholarships must be approved by the ministry.
- Please have respect for all Calvary staff who are working in the same area, this includes not leaving messes behind for the janitors.
- Please do not allow your children to run through the halls, play in any of the classrooms, or be a disruption to those working.
- Pray for the ministry, that we fulfill the call of the ministry and glorify God in all we do.
